

	<p>Dave Cortese is a lifelong resident of San Jose, California USA. He is currently serving as President of Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors, representing District 3, which includes San Jose, Milpitas and Sunnyvale. Before being elected to the Board of Supervisors, he served as a Councilman and Vice Mayor for the City of San Jose. Cortese served for eight years as a trustee for the East Side Union High School District. In his current term on the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors, his accomplishments include securing funding for more school crossing guards and an evaluation of "hot spots" of pedestrian and bicycle accidents and fatalities in order to improve conditions. He helped form an anti-Human Trafficking task force by sponsoring an \$850,000 budget item.</p> <p>In his first term, his accomplishments included: securing funding for transportation projects, including the BART to San Jose extension, upgrades to the County's expressway system, extending VTA Light Rail to Eastridge Mall, and improvements to HWY 101 and the Tully Road, Capitol Expressway, and Yerba Buena interchanges; approving a new ambulance service and protecting farmland and open space, as well as introducing new Sunshine Laws.</p>
	<p>Kansen Chu is currently serving in the California State Assembly. He is representing the 25th district, encompassing parts of the South Bay. Prior to being elected to the state assembly, he was a San Jose city councilmember representing District 4, which encompasses the communities of Berryessa, Alviso, and North San Jose. As City Councilman, Chu has served in various committees and commission such as the County's Recycling and Waste Reduction Commission, Chair of the North San Jose Neighborhoods Planning, and more.</p>
	<p>Manh Nguyen is currently serving as San Jose City Councilmember, District 4. He has been a long time resident of District 4. Nguyen was a journalist for almost thirty years, keeping residents informed and engaged on critical civic issues, provided them with insights into our local government, and helped them improve their quality of life by promoting public health.</p>
	<p>Patrick Burt is currently the Mayor of the city of Palo Alto where he has also been a Councilmember and Mayor in 2010 where he has served in various committees such as infrastructure, Water District, Transportation and more. Professionally, he was Founder and CEO of Acteron, Material science surface technologies, and CEO of Vascular Access Technologies, Inc. Currently, he is a member of the Technical Advisory Board of Silver Bullet Therapeutics, Owner of Palo Alto Tech Group which provide strategic advice and business development to early stage companies in materials engineering, CEO of TheraDep Technologies, Inc, and Senior Advisor for Enbio.</p>
	<p>Peter Ohtaki is currently Councilmember of the city of Menlo Park, he had served as Mayor. He is also running for California State Assemblyman. Professionally, he is currently Vice President and Regional Emergency Manager for Wells Fargo. Previously, Peter was the Executive Director of the California Resiliency Alliance (CRA), Prior to starting the CRA, Peter was the Chief Financial Officer and co-founder of a technology company. He has also worked in Investment Banking for Morgan Stanley, Merrill Lynch, and C.E. Unterberg Towbin, where he financed technology companies.</p>
	<p>Lily Mei is currently the Vice Mayor of Fremont. She was also was the President of the Asian Pacific Islander School Board Members Association (APISBMA) for California. She is a board member/advisor of Citizens for Better Community, Music for Minors II and South Bay Chinese Service Club. Professionally, she serves as worldwide sales operations controller and has led a global high-technology trade association representing industry leaders to develop best practices to advance intellectual property protection.</p>
	<p>Johnny Khamis is currently a member of the San Jose City Council. Professionally, he is the CEO and founder of Western Benefit Solutions, a San Jose-based firm that deals in benefit plan consulting. He was member of San Jose Small Business Development Commission. Johnny has been dedicated to attending all of the neighborhood and community associations meetings in the District, as well as volunteering his time with organizations like Almaden Cares, Almaden Kiwanis, his sons' Boy Scout troop and the Martin Fontana Parks Association.</p>
	<p>Chappie Jones is currently San José City Councilmember. Professionally, Jones has held sales management positions with Apple and AT&T, was an executive manager with Cornerstone Consulting and Technology and owned a technology service business. Jones has, also, been Chair of San Jose Chamber of Commerce Infrastructure Committee, Commissioner of San Jose Small Business Development Commission, Member of City of San Jose General Fund Deficit Reduction Elimination Taskforce, Commissioner of San Jose Neighborhoods Commission for District 1, spearheading budgeting recommendations for the San Jose City Council, among other committees.</p>
	<p>Ro Khanna is an American teacher, lawyer and politician. He served as the Deputy Assistant Secretary in the United States Department of Commerce under President Barack Obama where he led international trade missions and worked to increase United States exports and was later appointed to the White House Business Council. Professionally, he has worked in Wilson Sonsini Goodrich & Rosati, a law firm located in Silicon Valley and worked on contractor fraud cases. Khanna teaches economics at Stanford University and law at the Santa Clara University School of Law, and has taught American Jurisprudence at San Francisco State University.</p>
